ASSESSMENTS:

ACT and SAT:

Students need to take either ACT or SAT or both during their Junior and Senior years for college entrance. Register online at the sites listed below. Additional registration information is located in the DCHS Library GO Center:

If you are planning to attend South Plains College, ACT is preferred for applying to SPC scholarships.

TSI: TSI is given frequently at DCHS. If you haven't taken a TSI Assessment, you will need to register in the DCHS Counseling office to take it.

APPLYING: APPLYING TO COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES/TECHNICAL SCHOOLS

FIRST: Check the college website for procedures

APPLYING TO A **TEXAS** COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY:

APPLYING TO **ANY OTHER** COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY:

Go to the college's web site and find admission requirements

COLLEGE DAY:

The District shall excuse a student for up to two days during the student's junior year and up to two days during the student's senior year to visit an accredited institution of higher education. A student shall be required to submit verification of such visits in accordance with administrative regulations.

Juniors and Seniors are allowed two college days per year. Obtain TWO forms from the counseling office:

1. Assignment Form: Collect your assignments.
2. College Day Form: Have it signed by an administrator and then give it to the Denver City High School Attendance Clerk **prior** to the travel date.

SCHOLARSHIPS:

Go to: www.dcisd.org AND click on the Scholarship link at the left

COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS: Located on the college site

The majority of your scholarship money is from colleges.

ATHLETES: Students wanting to compete in college athletics need to register on the **NCAA Eligibility Center** website: <https://web3.ncaa.org/ecwr3/> NCAA requires high school transcripts be sent to them. You will need to request one be sent by filling out a "Transcript Request Form" in the office.

TRANSCRIPTS:

High School Transcripts:

Obtain and complete a transcript request form in the counseling office with the Denver City High School Registrar. You will need to request two transcripts:

1st Transcript Request: After you submit your college application

2nd Transcript Request: At the end of May your senior year

PLEASE ALLOW AT LEAST ONE WEEK FOR THE DCHS REGISTRAR TO MAIL YOUR TRANSCRIPT.

South Plains College and UTPB Transcripts:

If you are a student who has had dual credit classes or are currently enrolled in any dual credit classes, then you will need to request a South Plains College and/or UTPB transcripts either online or by phone.
