- 3. Applicants will be considered on the basis of service in their church (50%), financial need (30%), and community service/extracurricular activities (20%).
- 4. Applications must be thoroughly completed to be considered.
- 5. Applications must be received by First Baptist Church no later than April 30, 2019.
- 6. Applicants must consent to a personal interview by members of the committee if requested to do so.
- 7. Scholarship recipients are responsible for notifying First Baptist Church immediately if changes affecting information in the application occur prior to the beginning of the academic year in which the scholarship will be applied.
- 8. Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the awardees with proof of enrollment.
- All information in the application will be maintained as personal and confidential except for the non-financial information that may be shared during awards presentations.
