One non-renewable scholarship is available in the amount of \$500.00. This will be subject to confirmation that the requirements of grade point and enrollment have been met.

Eligibility

- Graduating high school seniors must have a minimum 3.00 G.P.A
- Denver City High School Senior to graduate in May 2022.
- Applicants must provide a copy of their most recent transcript.
- Applicant must be of good character as evidenced by at least one letter of recommendation. The letter must be from a teacher, principal, counselor, etc.
- Scholarship will be awarded on the basis of funds available and the applicant's eligibility.
- Applications must be received by Denver City ISD and Estacado Federal Credit Union no later than May 9, 2022.
- **Student must be either an EFCU member or child of EFCU member. Account may be opened prior to reception of scholarship.**

Recipients

- Recipient must maintain full-time enrollment status at the college or university of their choice.
- Recipient must furnish an official schedule from the college of choice and demonstrate a willingness to pursue a course of higher learning.
- Scholarship is payable to school and the student must provide information for payment by 12/31/22.
