Knights of Columbus Scholarship Form

Who may apply: Any graduating senior who plans to pursue an eligible program of study in college, vocational/technical school, or military service.

Eligible Program: The definition of an eligible program shall be one which is expected to lead to a college degree or comparable to that contained in the federal vocational legislation. A student should plan to carry a minimum load of 12 semester credit hours each term. Do not apply if you are only a High School Junior.

Length of Grant: This Grant is for one year only and is not renewable.

Amount of Award: There will be scholarships in the amount of \$500 awarded this year from the Knights of Columbus Council 8517.

All scholarships are in the form of certificates of award conditioned upon the student's submission of evidence of enrollment in an eligible program. Upon receipt of a verification of enrollment statement from the school, the Grand Knight (or appointed representative) will cause a check in the proper amount to be issued to the student.

Application Process: Applications should be addressed to: *Grand Knight, Knights of Columbus Council 8517, 621 North Avenue C, Denver City, TX 79323.* Applications should be received by <u>May 1 of the year in which the student graduates</u> or receives a GED.

Application: Typewritten applications and statements are preferred. Photocopies are acceptable.

- 1. If there is insufficient space on the application for appropriate response to a question, pages may be added.
- 2. Exhibits: Should be neat, concise, and in chronological order
- Order of Exhibits:
 - A. Completed application
 - B. Statement of applicant of not more than 200 words, summarizing his or her previous activities and objectives for the future.
 - C. A letter from a parent or person having knowledge of the applicant's interests to verify the applicant's intent to continue his or her education.
 - D. No more than 2 letters of endorsement from responsible non-relatives who have had an opportunity to observe the applicant's character, industry, disposition, and general worthiness.
 - E. Grade record from the two previous years
 - F. Any other information you would like to submit.

Judging will be based on but not limited to the following criteria:

- Demonstrated aptitude for chosen vocation.
- Church, school and civic activities
- Grades Demonstrating ability to succeed in a higher learning institution
- Application Completeness, neatness, and ability to follow directions
- Motivation expressed general worthiness and desire.

The Committee shall consist of: A committee appointed by the Grand Knight containing at least three and up to six members. The committee will recommend scholarship awarding applicants, and the entire council will vote on the recommendation.
