














#### **Career/Military Ready Graduates**






### Denver City ISD Student Demographic Summary 1501 Students



# Section 6: Student Performance in Postsecondary Institutions

TEC Section §29.306 requires each district to publish, as part of its Annual Report, a report on student performance in postsecondary institutions during the first year enrolled after graduation from high school.

The most current report is for the 2021-2022 graduates.

- Student performance is measured by the Grade Point Average (GPA) earned by 2021-2022 high school graduates who attended public 4-year and 2-year institutions of higher education in fiscal year 2022.
- For each student, the grade points and college-level semester credit hours earned by the student in Fall 2021, Spring 2022, and Summer 2022 are added together and averaged to determine the GPA.
